

RESULTS FROM PREVIOUS INTERESTS TESTING

In case you have already taken an interest inventory, like the Self-Directed Search or the Strong Interest Inventory, or a personality test like the Myers-Briggs or True Colors, look over the results of that test and write below any occupations that were suggested that still appeal to you.

The U.S. government provides a free interest test. The computerized version is called the Computerized Interest Profiler (CIP) and may be found at www.onetcenter.org/CIP.html. The alternative test, taken with paper and pencil instead of a computer, is called the O*Net Interest Profiler (IP) and may be downloaded at www.onetcenter.org/IP.html. Your results can be linked to an O*Net database of matching occupations. From the matching occupations, choose those that you think you would like and add them to your list.
